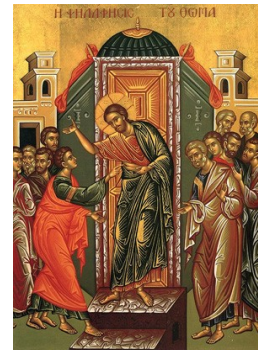

### Adult Religious Education Course on Wednesdays at 7 pm

A new series began in January: "Contemporary Moral Issues." Each week we tackle a moral or ethical issue (chosen by consensus of the class) in light of the Orthodox Tradition, using as a resource an excellent collection of short newspaper columns by Archpriest Stanley S. Harakas titled, *Contemporary Moral Issues*. (Copies are now available in the parish bookstore for \$13 apiece.) Fr. Stanley, former dean of Holy Cross Greek Orthodox School of Theology near Boston, MA, is our rector's long-time mentor in moral theology. The **next class session** will, God-willing, be on **April 26**, and the topic will **"Human Rights."**

### Do YOU Believe in the Resurrection of Christ—"Literally"?

Orthodox journalist Terry Mattingly's column notes: "A 2014 'Theological Awareness Benchmark Study' conducted by LifeWay Research asked: 'Are biblical accounts of the resurrection of Jesus accurate? Did this happen?' . . . Broken down by denominations, 91 percent of evangelical Protestants affirmed belief in the resurrection, to one degree or another, along with 84 percent of black Protestants, 73 percent of 'mainline' Protestants and 73 percent of Catholics." So . . . more than ¼ of our **Roman Catholic** friends do **NOT** believe!?! I would expect 100% of Orthodox to say "Yes!" - Archpriest Alexander
